



## *Public Works Technician*

The Town of Pembroke currently has an opening for a Public Works Technician.

### *Position Overview*

Employees in this class perform a variety of routine unskilled and semi-skilled tasks primarily related to maintenance and upkeep of all Town maintained grounds and lots, right of way mowing, landscaping, and debris removal. Work includes mowing, trimming, edging, weed eating, pulling weeds, and putting out straw around Town facilities, in public rights of way and other designated areas; debris pickup and cleaning of storm drains; and removing leaves from Town property and other designated facilities, such as the library. Work involves the operation of a variety of equipment including zero-turn and riding lawnmowers, trimmers, weed eater, backpack blower, pitchfork, shovel, rake, etc. Work is performed under regular supervision and is inspected for compliance with instructions, quality, and upon completion to determine that proper work methods are being followed and that assignments are carried out correctly.

### *Desirable Education and Experience:*

Graduation from high school and some experience in grounds or public facilities maintenance work; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
