



Electrical Maintenance Technician – The Town of Pembroke currently has an opening for an Electrical Maintenance Technician

Desirable Education and Experience:

Any combination of education and experience equivalent to graduation from high school supplemented by electrical technology course work and considerable related electrical experience; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.

An employee in this class performs semi-skilled and journey level electrical work installing, maintaining, troubleshooting electrical systems and equipment for pump stations, wells, wastewater treatment plant, and building systems. The employee works independently on a variety of projects and serves as a crew member when assisting with other projects. The employee is expected to have knowledges and experiences in moderately difficult industrial and household electrical work. Duties also include assisting with water and sewer line maintenance. Work assignments are received through supervisory personnel. Employees are subject to working in inside and outside environments, extreme temperatures, and hazards in the work including exposures to loud noises, vibrations, proximity to moving mechanical parts, electrical current, working in high places, exposure to chemicals, fumes, odors, dusts, mists, gases, and oils. Duties may expose employees to human body fluids and thus they are subject to the OSHA requirements on bloodborne pathogens. Workers are also subject to work in close quarters such as crawlspaces and small rooms. The employee is also subject to on-call work for after-hours emergency repairs for water and sewer line repairs. Work is performed under general supervision of the Public Works Director and is reviewed for lasting quality, effectiveness, appearance, and functionality through conference, inspection, and a review of records. Possession of a valid appropriate N. C. driver's license. Ability to obtain appropriate water distribution and sewer collection certifications.
