



Utility Maintenance Technician

The Town of Pembroke currently has an opening for a Utility Maintenance Technician.

Position Overview

An employee in this class performs semi-skilled work in the maintenance of specialized equipment and machinery in sewer lift stations. Work involves responsibility for monitoring the lift stations; maintaining proper records related to run hours, rainfall, generators, etc., that impact the lift stations; inspecting equipment in operation at the lift stations; inspecting the structure of the lift stations; maintaining pumps, motors, and equipment; and responding to wastewater spills and overflows. Work also involves maintaining the area around the lift stations to ensure easy access for employees and equipment and ensuring backup generators are in working order and properly fueled.

Desirable Education and Experience:

Graduation from high school and some mechanical or pump station maintenance experience; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
