



POLICE DETECTIVE

The Town of Pembroke currently has an opening for a Police Detective.

Desirable Education and Experience:

Graduation from high school, possession of a basic law enforcement certificate and minimum 3-5 years' experience as a law enforcement officer. Ideal candidates may possess an intermediate law enforcement certificate through the N.C. Criminal Justice Education and Training Standards Commission.

Essential Duties and Tasks:

An employee in this class performs investigatory criminal police work; conducts initial and follow-up investigations; interviews persons in connection with investigated incidents; develops contacts and information sources concerning criminal activities; performs undercover operations and surveillance work as required; arrests offenders; identifies, collects, and preserves physical evidence; prepares written reports of investigative activities; testifies in court regarding investigative activities; prepares related paperwork related to case management; prepares documents for district attorney and presentations to court; coordinates activities at crime accident scenes and performs additional duties as assigned.
